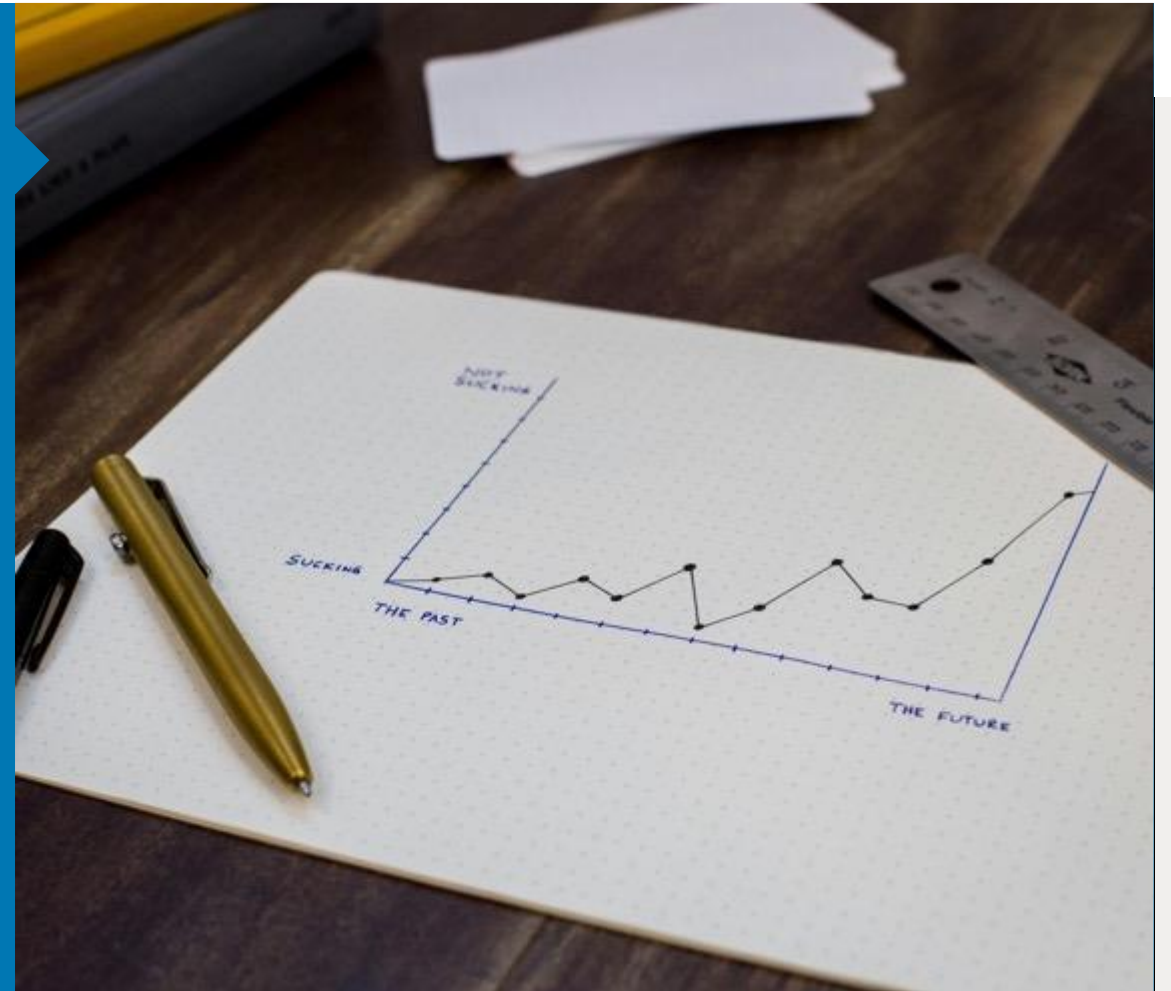


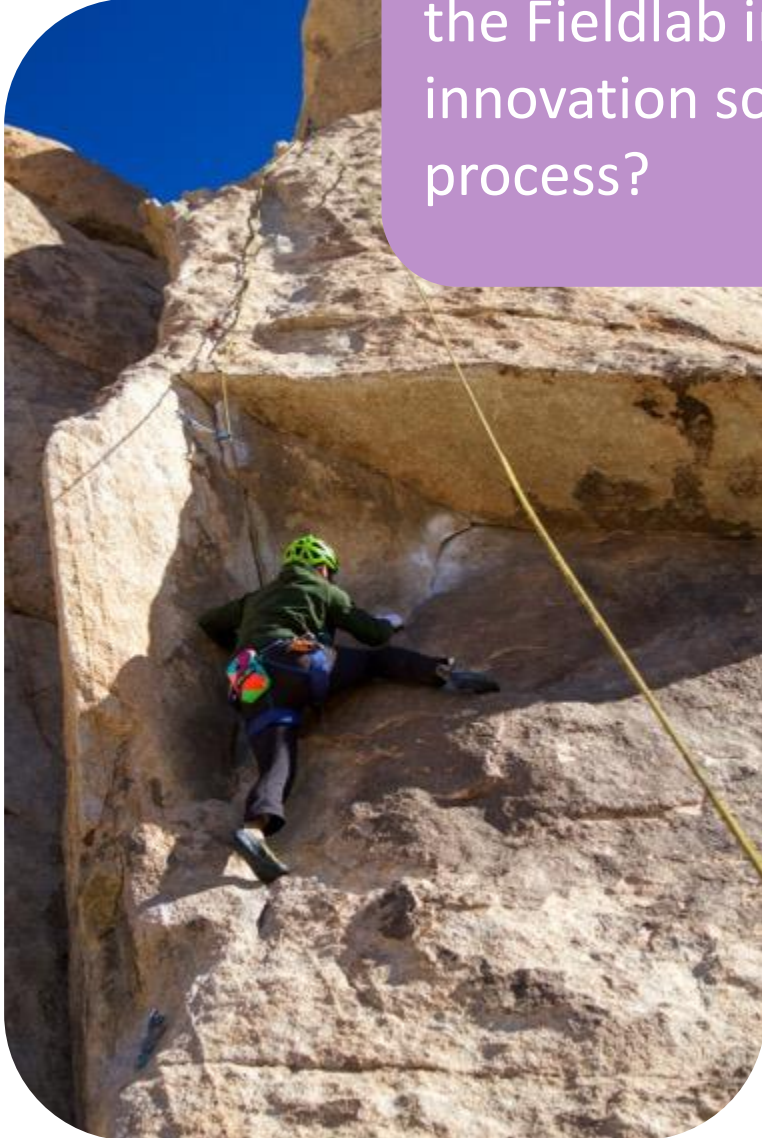

Multiple cases over time to understand processes in depth from multiple perspectives

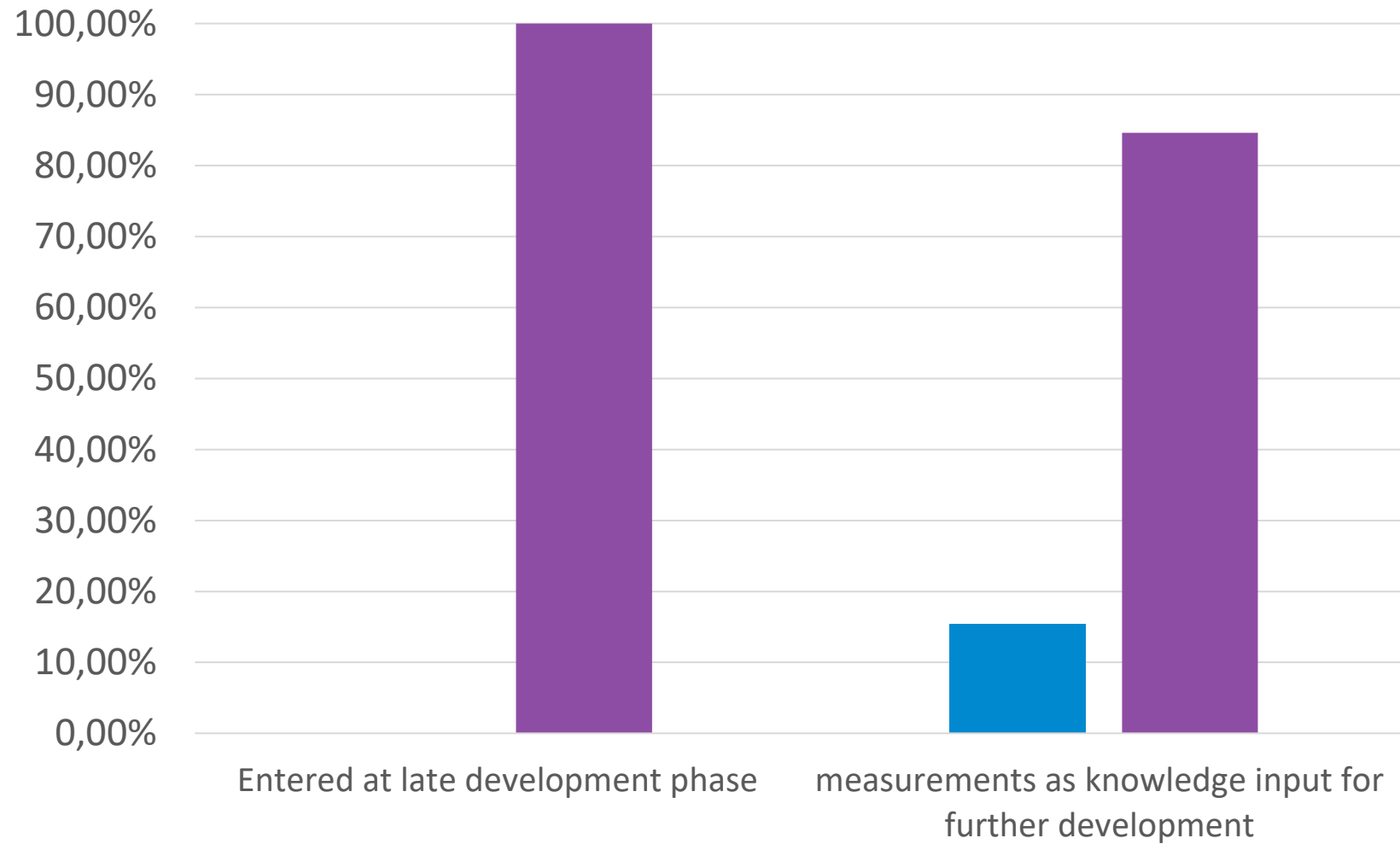

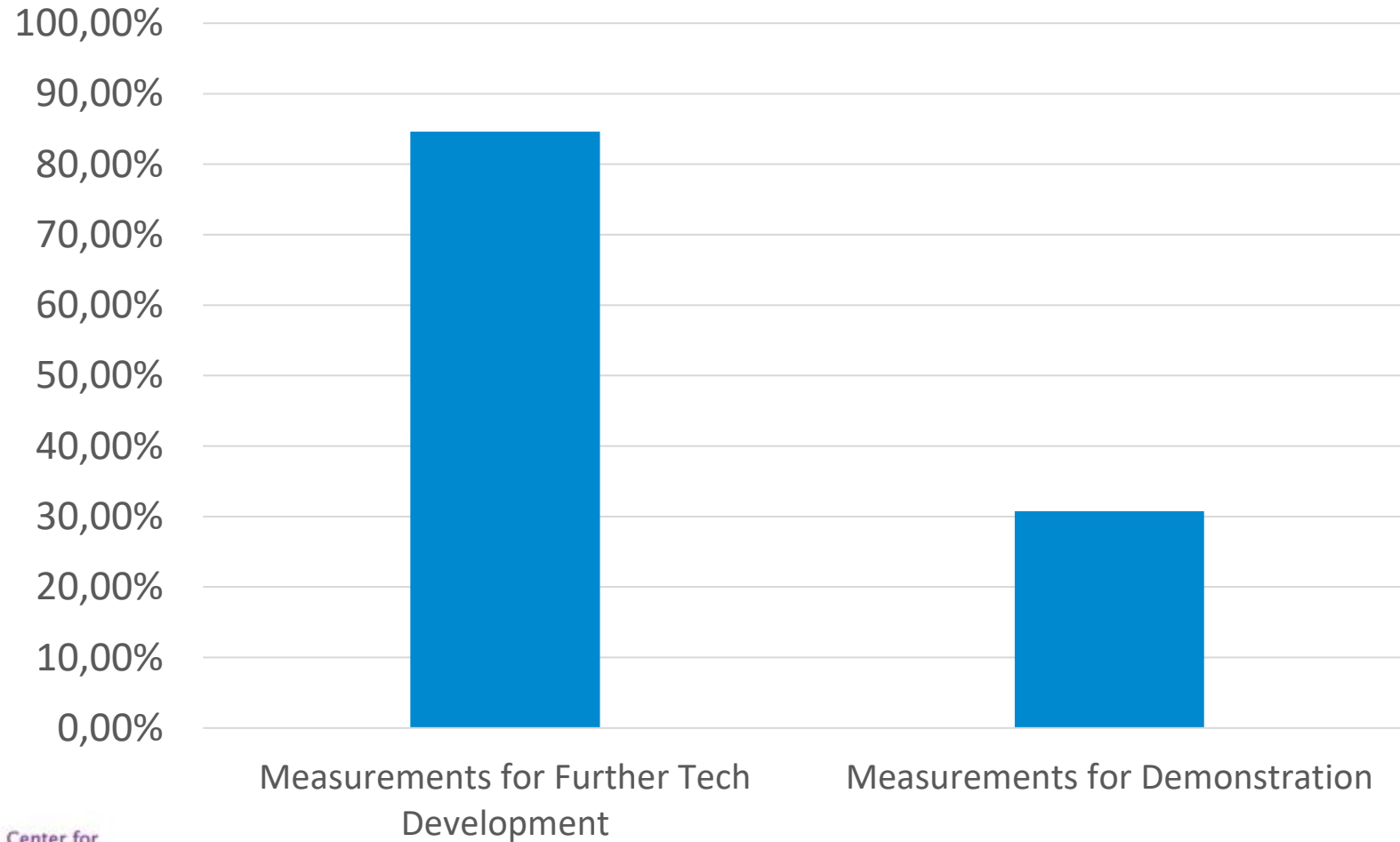

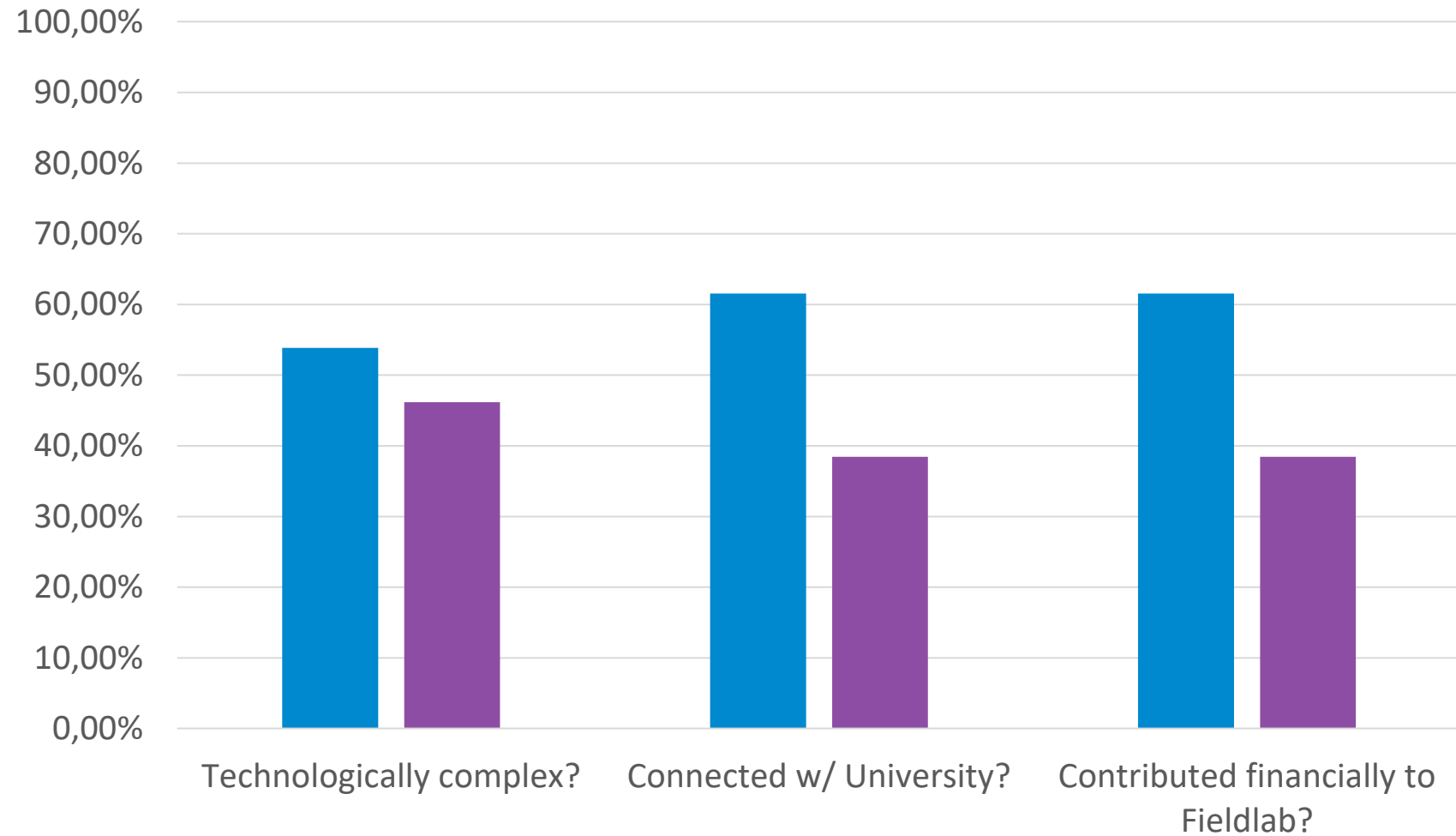

Average time spent in months:

14.93 months (start with 12-month contract)

% receiving an extension:

33.33% total (37.5% for complex solutions)

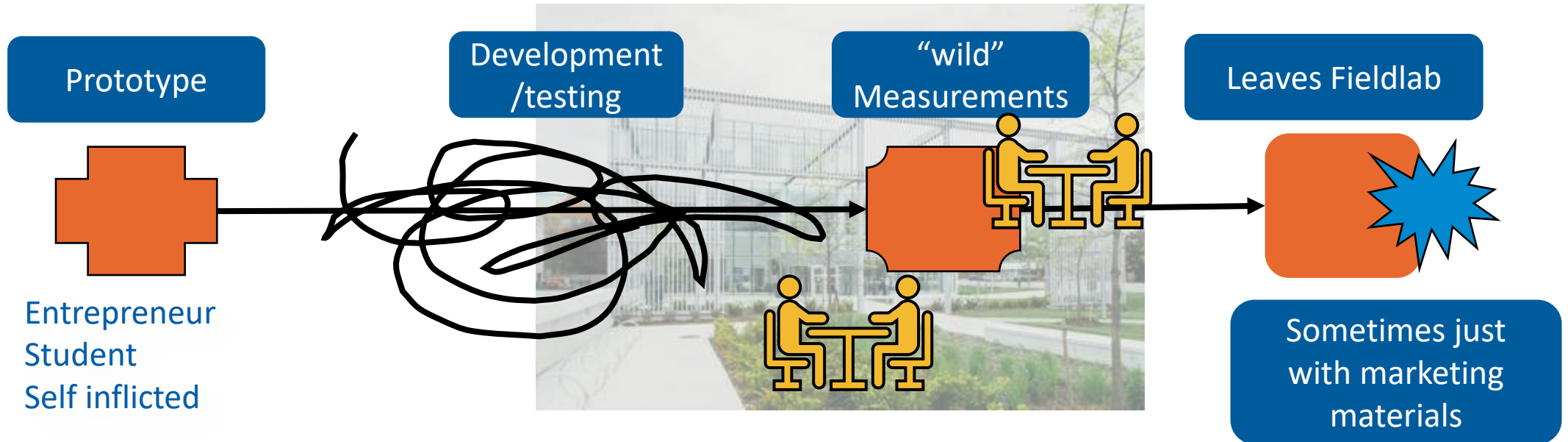
Average total number of partners:

7.31 (1.12 university, 4 private, 2.13 public)

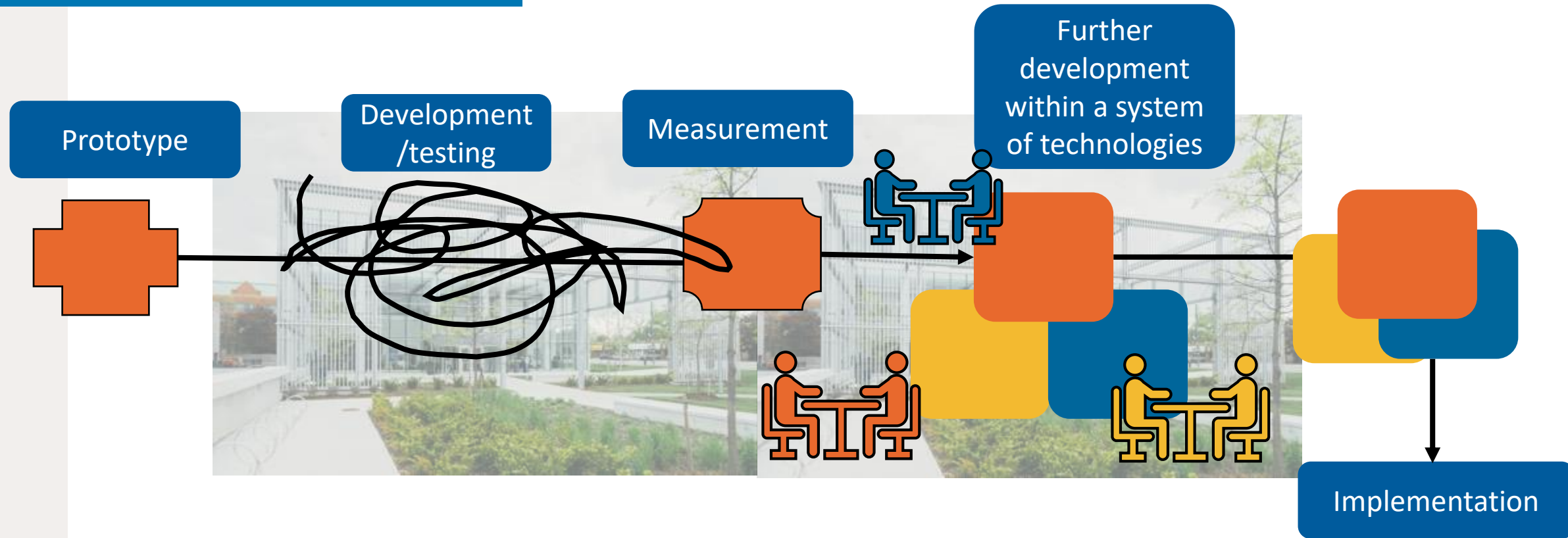
Still in existence?

88.89%, all the complex innovations still exist

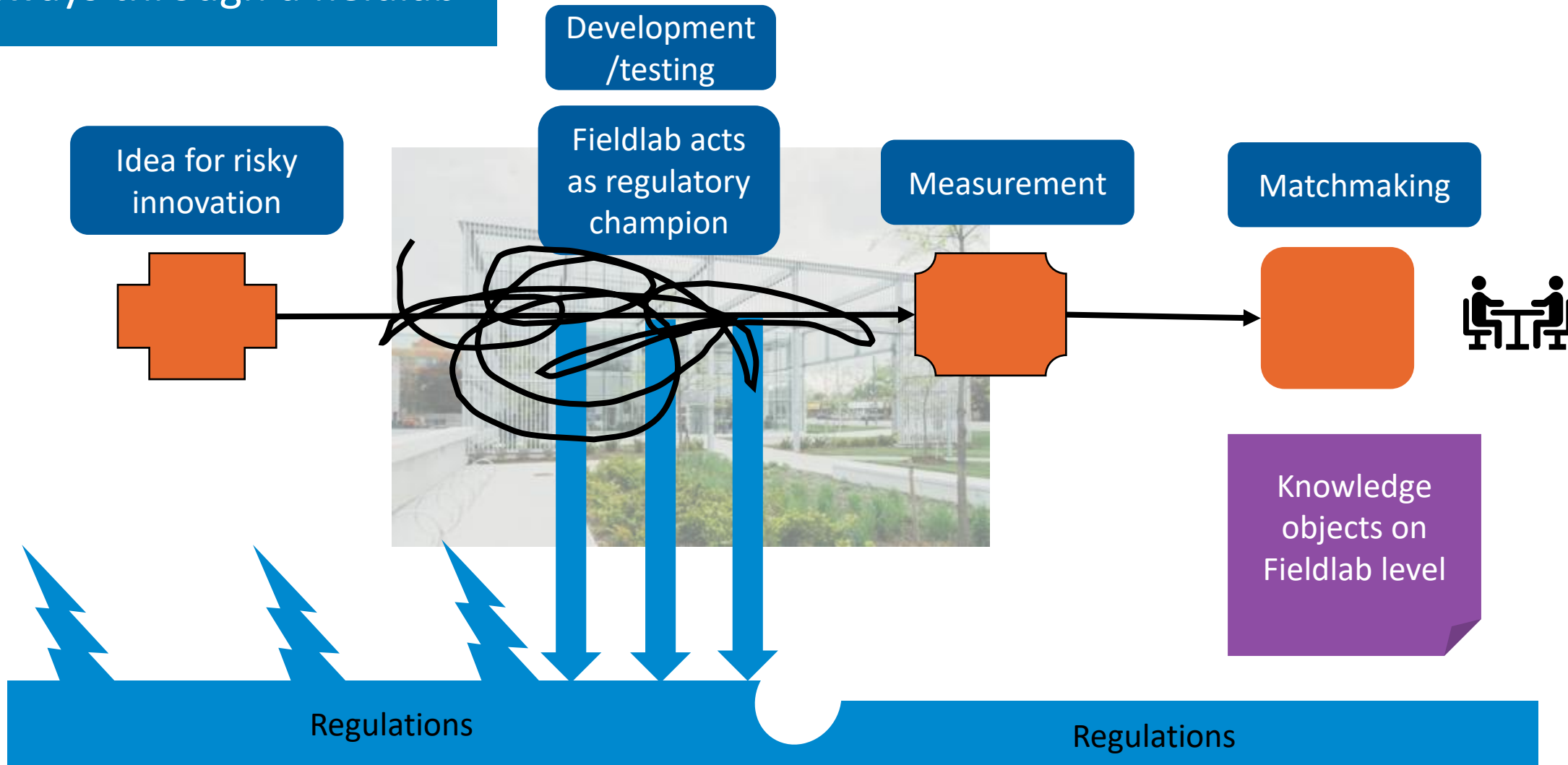
